### A. Manufactured/Mobile Home Park Regulations Amendment

**Consultant Sturtz** and the Planning Commission discussed recommended amendments to 19.06.120 including:

1. Stipulate compliance with the applicable landscaping and screening regulations in 19.06.020.
2. Include specific setback requirements to provide adequate building separation and buffer areas on the boundaries of a manufactured home park.
3. Require at least 15% of the gross area be in open space and recreational area available to all residents of the manufactured home park.

**Consultant Sturtz** explained tonight's discussion is just to see if the Planning Commission is interested in adding these items on the Docket. It is not for any decisions to be made.

**Commissioner Stephenson** moved to go ahead and put the Comprehensive Plan to add manufactured/mobile home parks to the Annual Docket for 2016. Motion seconded by Commissioner Harrison and passed 5-0.
