

ORDINANCE NO. 10

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE TIME AND PLACE OF MEETING OF  
THE TOWN COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the town of  
Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: The regular meeting of the town council  
shall be held on the first Tuesday of each month at the  
hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m. and said regular meetings may  
be adjourned from time to time during the month as  
necessity may require by a majority vote of the members  
of the council.

Section 2: The Mayor shall have the power to call  
special meetings at any time he may deem necessary, and  
three members of the council in his absence from the town,  
may do the same by giving written notice of said meeting  
to the other members.

Section 3: All meetings of the council shall be  
held in Grand Army Hall situated in Block No. 9 of the  
original townsite of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force  
and effect from and after its passage and publication  
as required by law.

Passed by the council in open session the 1st day  
of March, 1904.
