

ORDINANCE NO. 100

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE USE OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS AND ALL OTHER PLACES OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASH., OPEN TO THE PUBLIC FOR THE USE OF VEHICLES; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF; AND REPEALING CERTAIN ORDINANCES AND PARTS OF ORDINANCES.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That when any vehicle turning into another street to the left shall turn around the center of intersection of the two streets.

Section 2: When drivers desiring to turn to the right or left shall signal by holding right or left hand at right angles to the car.

Section 3: No person shall drive any vehicle over any hose belonging to the Fire Department of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 4: Any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall, upon conviction be punished by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days or by fine not to exceed one hundred dollars, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and publication according to law.
