

ORDINANCE NO. 102

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 85 ENTITLED AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF WATER SUPERINTENDENT, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND SALARY THEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR FIXING, REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE USE AND PRICE OF THE WATER SUPPLIED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance No. 85 be amended to read as follows, to-wit:

Section 32: The monthly rates for water shall be as follows:

Residence, including bath and toilet	
inside the corporate limits	\$1.50
outside the corporate limits	\$2.00
Restaurants	\$5.00
Lodging houses	\$3.00
Lodging houses and restaurants combined	\$7.50
Mercantile establishments	\$2.00
Livery barns	\$2.00
Schools	\$8.00
Creamery	\$3.00
Offices	\$1.50
Photograph galleries	\$1.75
Halls	\$1.50
Barber shop, no tub	\$1.50
Barber shop, one tub	\$2.00
Each additional tub	\$1.00
Blacksmith shop	\$1.50
Bakery	\$2.00
Slaughterhouse	\$5.00
Laundry	\$10.00
Meat market	\$2.00
Garage	\$6.00

Residence and business combined pay business rates
only.

Fire hydrants \$4.00 per hydrant per year.

Constant flow urinal, closet or sprinkler \$1.50 in addition to rate otherwise taken by premises.

Meter Rates:

Minimum per month \$2.50

First 1500 cubic feet 30 cents per hundred feet.

1500 feet to 3000 feet 20 cents per hundred feet.

3000 feet to 6000 feet 15 cents per hundred feet

6000 feet to 20,000 feet 10 cents per hundred feet.

Over 20,000 feet 8 cents per hundred feet.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after the first day of January, 1920.
