ORDINANCE NO. 104

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 38 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT AND REGULATE THE RUNNING AT LARGE OF CERTAIN ANIMALS WITHIN THE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOUNDING AND SALE OF THE SAME AND PRESCRIBING THE PUNISHMENT FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: That Section No. 3 of Ordinance No. 38 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The enclosure and barn known as the Brush Property located on Lots 7 and 8 Block 2 Original Townsite of Granite Falls, northwest corner of Galena Street and Cascade Ave., is hereby declared to be established as the Public Pound of said Town.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect on and after June 1, 1920.
