

ORDINANCE NO. 105

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES  
WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS AND DECLARING THE VIOLATION  
THEREOF A MISDEMEANOR.

THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, DOES ORDAIN:

Section 1: Any person who shall drive or operate, and every owner, lessee, or other person in charge thereof, who shall permit to be operated, any automobile, motorcycle or motor vehicle, on any public street or highway within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, at a rate of speed faster than one (1) mile in five minutes, at any crossing within the main thickly settled or business portion of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, or within one hundred yards of any school house, on school days between eight o'clock in the morning and five o'clock in the evening, within the said Town, or in any other portion of the said Town faster than one (1) mile in three minutes, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 2: Every motor vehicle using an internal combustion engine shall use an exhaust muffler shall not be cut out or disconnected within the limits of said Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 3: Any person convicted of any violation of this ordinance shall upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than five dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town jail for a period not exceeding thirty days, or by both fine and imprisonment.

Section 4: Ordinance No. 68 is hereby repealed.

Section 5: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
