

ORDINANCE NO. 108

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF OPERATING FOR HIRE TRUCKS, AUTO STAGES, AND JITNEY BUSES, WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING FOR LICENSES THEREOF, AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF THE SAID ORDINANCE OR ANY OF THE TERMS THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: No person, firm, or corporation shall operate a for hire truck, auto stage or jitney bus within the corporate limits of the town of Granite Falls, without first having obtained a license therefor.

Section 2: Applications for licenses for the operation of such trucks, auto stages or jitney busses shall be made to the Town Clerk of said town of Granite Falls, who shall issue such license upon payment of the hereinafter mentioned fee therefor, subject to the approval of the town council of said town, at the next meeting of said council. Said application shall describe the said truck, stage or bus, give the engine number and horsepower thereof, and the state license numbers issued therefor, with the name and mail address of the owner and operator of said truck, stage, or bus, and the seating capacity of such stage or bus and the tonnage capacity of such truck.

Section 3: If objection is made to the issuance of such license or to the continuance thereof, the said council will cause a hearing to be had on such objection and application, and give the applicant five days written notice thereof by mail to the address given in said application, and after said hearing, the said council may ratify said license or revoke the same for due and sufficient cause.

Section 4: The annual fee for said license shall be as follows:

Auto Stages	\$5.00
Jitneys	\$2.50
For Hire Trucks 1-1/2 ton and over	\$2.50
For Hire Trucks less than 1-1/2 ton	\$1.50

for the remainder of the calendar year.

Section 5: If any such license shall be revoked or cancelled and there is more than six months unexpired of the term for which said license shall be issued, one-half of the above mentioned fee shall be returned to the applicant.

Section 6: Any person, firm or corporation violating this ordinance or any of the terms thereof shall be punished by a fine of not less than five nor more than twenty-five dollars.
