

ORDINANCE NO. 113

AN ORDINANCE DEFINING NUISANCES AND PROVIDING PENALTY  
FOR VIOLATION THEROF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of the Town of Granite Falls, that section five of Ordinance numbered four be amended by adding and including the following: that it shall be unlawful to sell, barter or exchange, or to offer for sale or exchange within the limits of the Town of Granite Falls any firecracker, torpedo, fireworks or other like explosives without the written permission of the town council of said town. That anyone violating the foregoing shall be liable to conviction and shall be fined not to exceed Twenty-Five (\$25.00) Dollars together with costs of action. This ordinance to take effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
