

ORDINANCE NO. 114

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 3 OF ORDINANCE NO. 55, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PLACES OF AMUSEMENT IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASH., TO BE LICENSED, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE, DECLARING THE VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMEANOR AND FIXING THE PENALTY THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Sec. 3 of Ordinance No. 55 be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3: Upon application therefor and payment of the sum of five dollars to said Town a special license, which shall confer the same privileges as the general cense provided for in Section Two of this Ordinance, except that the same shall be valid for one week only, shall be issued. And upon application therefor and payment to said Town of the sum of two dollars, a license to open such place of amusement for the holding of a dance only, shall be issued.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after Feb. 1st, 1925.
