

ORDINANCE NO. 115

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 3, AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING ALL CIRCUSES, SHOWS, PEDDLERS, AND AGENTS, PERFORMING, OPERATING OR DOING BUSINESS IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON TO BE LICENSED, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THEIR LICENSE, DECLARING THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMEANOR AND FIXING THE PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Granite Falls,
Washington:

Section 1: That Section 1 of Ordinance 3 of said Town, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

For every peddler who peddles from a wagon, for a yearly license, (\$50.00) Fifty Dollars.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication according to law.
