

ORDINANCE NO. 116

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THE SALARY OF THE TOWN CLERK, AND THE TOWN TREASURER, OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: The Town Clerk shall receive a monthly salary of Twenty Dollars for his or her services and such other and further compensation as the Town Council may from time to time provide for the performance of any unusual or extra services required of him or her.

Section 2: The Town Treasurer shall receive a monthly salary of Twenty Dollars for his or her services and such other and further compensation as the Town council may from time to time provide for the performance of any unusual or extra services required of him or her.

Section 3: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after January 1st, 1926.
