

ORDINANCE NO. 119

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATION AND CONTROL OF MOTOR VEHICLES WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND FIXING PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That no motor vehicle shall be driven upon the streets of said Town at a greater speed than twenty miles per hour, or at any intersection of two streets at a greater speed than twelve miles per hour; or within three hundred feet of any school building between the hours of eight o'clock a.m. and five o'clock p.m. of any school day at a greater speed than twelve miles per hour.

Section 2: That any person desiring to park any motor vehicle in any of the streets of said Town shall park said vehicle at a point at least twenty feet distant from any street intersection and at right angles to the curb and with one front wheel touching the curb; that this section shall not apply to Stanley Street or that portion of Pioneer Street east of Granite Avenue where cars shall be parked parallel to the curb within two feet thereof and not within twenty feet of any street intersection.

Section 3: That no motor vehicle shall be driven upon any street with open cut-out or exhaust or any device or in any manner causing excessive or unusual noise.

Section 4: That no motor vehicle shall be operated upon any street between 1/2 hour after sundown in the evening and 1/2 before sunrise in the morning without at least one right front and one left front and one rear light burning; that said rear light shall be red in color.

Section 5: Any person convicted of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be fined not less than two or more than twenty-five dollars beside cost of action.

Section 6: Any ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
