

ORDINANCE NO. 125

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 65, AN ORDINANCE CREATING THE OFFICE OF WATER SUPERINTENDENT, PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND SALARY THEREOF, AND PROVIDING FOR FIXING , REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE USE, AND PRICE OF THE WATER SUPPLIED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That Section No. 32 of Ordinance No. 65, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"That the monthly rates for all water service to any property served by the Municipal Water Works, shall be discounted to an amount equal to Thirty Three and one-third percent (33 1/3%), provided the said water rentals charged against any such property, and owing and due the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, shall be paid into the office of the Town Treasurer in full not later than the tenth day of the month in which same is due, provided however that the discount rate shall not apply to water charges unpaid prior to July 1st, 1932.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1st, 1932.
