

ORDINANCE NO. 126

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE OF BEER AND WINES OF SUCH ALCOHOLIC CONTENT AS IS PERMITTED BY THE LAWS OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA AND THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to sell either directly or indirectly by any subterfuge or to keep for sale any beer or wine in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington without first obtaining a license therefor in accordance with the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 2: That licenses for the sale of beer or wine of such alcoholic content as is permitted by the laws of the United States of America and the State of Washington, shall be granted by the Town of Granite Falls to persons described and under the following conditions:

To persons by whom beer and wine is sold only in bottles in the original containers, upon payment of the annual license fee of Fifteen Dollars (\$15.00).

To persons by whom beer and wine is sold either in bottles or on draught to be served on the premises upon payment of an annual fee of fifty dollars (\$50.00).

The annual license fee for wholesale distributor of beer and wine, shall be (\$5.00) five dollars.

Section 3: The holder of a government license for the sale of beer or wine or both, in the Town of Granite Falls, shall be deemed to be engaged in the sale of beer or wine or both in said Town, and said government license shall be prima facie evidence thereof; provided that this section shall not apply to licensed druggists engaged in the drug business.

Section 4: Any person desiring a license under the provisions of this ordinance shall file with the Town Clerk, an application in writing which application shall state the name of the applicant and the place where the proposed business is to be conducted, all applications must be accompanied by cash or certified check in the amount of license fee provided by this ordinance.

Section 5: Licenses shall be granted only to citizens of the United States of America who have residents of the Town of Granite Falls for at least one year last past. No retail license shall be granted to any wholesale or manufacturer. All licenses for the year 1933 shall expire on the thirty-first day of December, 1933 and the fee shall be three-fourths of the annual license fee above fixed.

All licenses granted under this ordinance shall not be transferred nor shall any change in the location of the business under such license be permitted except upon notice to the Town Council and the same proceedings had thereon as in cases of granting of the original license, and the power to grant or revoke any beer or wine license shall remain fixed in the Town Council.

Section 6: No licensed dealer of such wine or beer shall permit any breach of the peace or decorum or any noisy or disorderly conduct upon the premises where such beer or wine is licensed to be sold.

Section 7: It shall be unlawful to sell beer or wine to any person under the age of legal majority or to employ any minor at a place where beer or wine is drunk on the premises.

Section 8: Any person found guilty of the violation of the terms of this ordinance shall pay a fine of not less than \$50.00 or more than \$100.00 or to be sentenced to serve thirty days in the Town jail or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 9: The Town Council shall have full authority and power to declare any license forfeited for the violation of any of the terms upon which it is granted, or of the provisions of this ordinance, even though the party so offending has not been convicted in any court for the violation of any such terms.

Section 10: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
