

ORDINANCE NO. 129

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE REGISTRATION OF VOTERS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, UNDER THE PERMANENT REGISTRATION LAW, REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That pursuant to Chapter 1, Laws of Washington, 1933, providing for the permanent registration of voters residing in the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, in order to be qualified to vote at any election held after January 1st, 1934, the Town Clerk for the said Town will register all voters applying in person at the office of the said Town Clerk, as provided by law for the permanent registration of voters, in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law.
