

ORDINANCE NO. 13

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE WIDTH OF GRANITE AVE. IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON FROM THE NORTH BOUNDARY LINE OF THE CORPORATE LIMITS TO A POINT SEVENTY-FIVE FEET SOUTH OF THE SOUTH-EAST CORNER OF BLOCK SEVENTEEN OF THE ORIGINAL TOWNSITE OF GRANITE FALLS; PROHIBITING THE ERECTION OF ANY STRUCTURE INSIDE OF THE EAST AND WEST BOUNDARY LINES OF SAID STREET AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the council of the town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: The width of Granite Avenue in the town of Granite Falls, from the north boundary line of the corporate limits of said town to a point seventy-five (75) feet south of the southeast corner of Block 17, of the original townsite of Granite Falls, is hereby established at seventy-five (75) feet of which twenty-six (26) feet shall lie west of the section line between sections 24 and 13 in Twp. 30 N R 6 E. W.M. and sections 18 and 19 Twp. 30 N.R. 7 E.W.M. and forty-nine (49) feet east of said section lines.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to build any structure of any kind on Granite avenue within the east and west boundary lines thereof as by this ordinance established.

Section 3: Any person, firm or corporation convicted of a violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, together with the costs of prosecution which costs shall be added to and become a part of the fine and shall be committed to the town jail until such fine be paid.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
