

ORDINANCE NO. 130

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF SLOT MACHINES,
ETC., IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite
Falls, Washington:

Section 1: Any person, firm or corporation who shall
have in his possession, or shall place or permit to be
placed or kept in any building or part thereof, owned,
leased or occupied by him, and table, slot machine, or
other article, device or apparatus operated for the losing
or winning of money or property or any representative of
either, shall pay into the Town Treasury for each such
table, slot machine or other article, device or apparatus,
a monthly fee or license of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents
(\$2.50).

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in
conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Failure on the part of any firm, person
and or corporation to make payment as provided in Section
No. 1 of this ordinance on all such tables, slot machines,
or apparatus, in his or their possession, will be promptly
followed by confiscation or destruction or both of the
said properties by the Town Council by their agent, the
town Marshal.
