

ORDINANCE NO. 133

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING OF SOLICITORS, CANVASSERS, STREET PEDDLERS, HOUSE-TO-HOUSE SALES MEN, WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND FIXING THE PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That no person, association or corporation shall solicit, canvass or peddle for compensation, or make a house to house solicitation for sale of any merchandise, article of apparel or any representative of money or merchandise, within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, without first obtaining a license therefor as provided in this ordinance.

Section 2: Upon application therefor and payment of the sum of Five Dollars to the said Town, a license shall be issued which shall confer the privilege of soliciting, canvassing, house to house selling or merchandise or its representative, within the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, provided however that nothing in this ordinance shall prevent any resident of said Town from making a house to house canvass or solicitation for the purpose of sale of merchandise from any established local business, or census of population or other legal purpose, or for distribution of goods sold from merchants or others regularly established within the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 3: That any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of the ordinance shall be fined not less than Twenty five (\$25.00) Dollars or imprisoned in the Town jail for ten days.
