ORDINANCE NO. 134

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PLACES OF AMUSEMENT IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, TO BE LICENSED, FIXING THE AMOUNT OF THE LICENSE, DECLARING THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMEANOR, AND FIXING THE PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: All places of amusement in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, shall pay into the Treasury of said Town, a fee of Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per month, for each Card Table, operated for hire or where a fee is charged for the use thereof.

Section 2: Any person, persons, or corporation convicted of violation of the provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than Ten Dollars or more than Twenty-five Dollars.
