

ORDINANCE NO. 139

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PLACES OF AMUSEMENT IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS TO BE LICENSED, FIXING THE AMOUNTS OF THE LICENSE, DECLARING THE VIOLATION OF ITS PROVISIONS A MISDEMEANOR AND FIXING THE PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 134 be and hereby is repealed.

Section 2. All places of amusement in Granite Falls, Washington shall pay into the treasury of said Town a fee of One Dollar (\$1.00) per month for each card table operated for hire or where a fee is charged therefor.

Section 3. Any person, persons or corporation convicted of violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction be fined not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00).
