ORDINANCE NO. 140

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 70 INsofar AS THE SAME RELATES TO RIDING BICYCLES ON SIDEWALKS AND SIDEWALK STRIPS.

BE IT ENACTED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful to ride any bicycle upon any sidewalk or sidewalk strip within the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls, at any time

Section 2. That after sunset every bicycle shall be equipped with a lighted lamp in front and a reflector on the rear mud guard.

Section 3. That bicycles riders must observe "the rules of the road" shall ride on the right side of the street and when turning into another street to the left shall turn around the center of the intersection of the two streets and shall make the hand signs required of motor vehicle drivers when turning to right or left.

Section 4. That it shall be unlawful for any bicycle rider to carry another person upon his bicycle when riding upon Granite Avenue or Stanley Street.

Section 5. These regulations are deemed necessary for public safety and any person violating any provision of this ordinance shall upon conviction be punished by imprisonment not exceeding two days, or by fine not to exceed \$20.00 or by both fine and imprisonment at the discretion of the court.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and publication according to law and any ordinance or part of ordinance in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.
