

ORDINANCE NO. 145

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE VACATION OF CERTAIN STREETS
IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town
of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That in accordance with an action of
the Town Council, November 29, 1938, relative to petition
for vacation of certain streets after due notice and
publication according to law, which streets have never
been opened or improved, it is hereby ordered

Section 2: That the following named streets be
and are hereby vacated:

The first street north of Stanley street,
running east and west from Kentucky Ave., to
Alder street.

ALSO, The street running north from the
above named street a distance of 410 feet, being
the northblock of Indiana Avenue.

ALSO, the street running east from the last
named street to Alder street,

All as laid out in the plat of the Town of
Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force
and effect upon its passage and publication according
to law.
