

ORDINANCE NO. 146

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO BUILDING OUTDOOR TOILETS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That on and after the date of publication of this Ordinance it shall be unlawful to construct any privy or outdoor toilet within the Town limits of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2: Any person violating this ordinance shall be punished by imprisonment not to exceed 10 days or by fine not less than \$25.00 nor more than \$50.00 or by both fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.
