

ORDINANCE NO. 162

AN ORDINANCE SETTING FORTH REASONS FOR AN INCREASE IN AND FIXING THE RATES FOR WATER SUPPLIED BY THE MUNICIPAL WATER WORKS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND PROVIDING FOR A DISCOUNT FROM SAID WATER RATES UNDER CONDITIONS HEREIN PRESCRIBED.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That due to rapidly increasing costs of labor and materials, an increase in rates for water supplied by the Municipal Water Works of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington is deemed necessary for the continued successful operation of said Water Works.

Section 2: The monthly rates for water shall be as follows:

Residence, including bath & toilet- inside corporate limits)	\$ 1.80
outside corporate limits	2.40
Restaurants	2.40
Lodging Houses	2.40
Taverns	2.40
Mercantile Establishments	2.40
Schools	9.60
Creamery	2.40
Offices	1.80

Barber shops: 1 tub	2.40
Each additional tub	1.20
Blacksmith Shops	1.80
Bakeries	2.40
Meat Markets	2.40
Garages	2.40

METER RATES:

Minimum, per month	2.40
First 1500 cu. ft, per 100 cu ft.	.35
1500 to 3000 cu. ft, per 100 cu. ft.	.24
3000 to 6000 cu. ft, per 100 cu. ft.	.18
6000 to 20,000 cu. ft., per 100 cu. ft.	.12
Over 20,000 cu. ft, per 100 cu. ft.	.10
Constant Flow Urinal, Closet or Sprinkler, add to above	1.00

Section 3: A discount of 25 cents shall be allowed on all of the above monthly rates provided such water rentals charged against such property due and owing to the Town of Granite Falls Washington shall be paid into the office of the Town Treasurer in full not later than the 10th day of the month in which same is due.

Section 4: All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5: This ordinance shall become effective on and after April 1, 1942.
