

ORDINANCE NO. 165

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EXPENSES AND FOR PAYMENT OF SALARIES TO MAYOR AND COUNCILMEN OF THE TOWN OF GRANTIE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That the mayor and members of the Council of the Town of Granite Falls shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the discharge of their official duties upon presentation of a claim therefor and after allowance of and approval of the same by resolution of the City Council.

Section 2: That the Mayor and Councilmen of the Town of Granite Falls shall receive as salary the sum of Three dollars per meeting for not more than two council meetings each month and payment thereof shall commence when each of said officials shall be qualified to receive the same under the applicable law.

Section 3: That all salaries and expenses shall be paid out of the current expense fund of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 4: That this ordinance is enacted under the provisions of Chapter 115 of the 1941 sessions laws of the State of Washington.

Section 5: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and they are hereby repealed.

Section 6: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect after passage, approval and due publication.
