

ORDINANCE NO. 166

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT OF SALARY TO THE TOWN MARSHAL, WATER SUPERINTENDENT AND STREET SUPERINTENDENT, OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AND FIXING THE AMOUNT THEREOF, AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONNECTION THEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That commencing January 1, 1943, the monthly salary of the Town Marshal shall be the sum of \$35.00. The monthly salary of the Water Superintendent shall be \$85.00. The monthly salary of the Street Superintendent shall be \$55.00.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication according to law.

Section 3: That all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
