

ORDINANCE NO. 170

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STATE AID FUND TO RECEIVE STATE AID APPROPRIATIONS AND PROVIDING FOR EXPENDITURES THEREFROM.

The Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington does hereby ordain:

Section 1. There is hereby established a fund to receive State aid appropriations to be known as the "State Aid Fund" into which all such appropriations shall be placed.

Section 2. The fund therein shall be subject to expenditures without regard to budget laws during 1943 and subject to budget laws thereafter for any of the following purposes under proper authority from the Town Council given in same manner as other bills of the Town, salaries and wages, supplies material and equipment for police and fire protection, health and sanitation, libraries, parks and civilian defense.

Passed by the Town Council and approved by the Mayor this 7th day of June 1943.
