

ORDINANCE NO. 171

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE TOWN LIMITS AND PROVIDING A CHARGE FOR THE SAME.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1. That because of the increased cost of collecting garbage and expense connected with the care of the garbage dump it has become necessary to discontinue the free service and to make a charge therefor.

Section 2. That commencing August 1, 1943, a charge of Twenty-Five Cents (.25) monthly, payable in advance, shall be made against every householder or place of business requiring such service, except those who can show they have no collection for a period of six months, payable to the Town Treasurer at the same time the water rent is paid, provided that if more than one collection is necessary in any month that an additional charge shall be made for such added collection.

Section 3. That the garbage to be collected shall be, as before, only for dry material and no sloppy matter or dead animals shall be permitted to be included in the garbage.

Section 4. That all garbage shall be placed in suitable containers for easy handling and left in a convenient place for collection and shall not be allowed to accumulate in any manner so as to become offensive or dangerous, or disposed of in any other manner about the premises. That the date for collection shall be the last Saturday in each month.

Section 5. That this Ordinance is necessary for the protection and health of all of the people and failure to comply with any part thereof shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a fine of not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) or more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the Town jail not exceeding 30 days or by both such fine and imprisonment. This Ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication.
