

ORDINANCE NO. 172

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 162 FIXING WATER RATES FOR SUPPLY FURNISHED BY MUNICIPAL WATER SYSTEM OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1. That due to increasing costs of labor and material an increase in the rates for water supplied by the Municipal Water Works of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, is deemed necessary for maintenance of the said Water Works and for providing a sinking fund to reduce the outstanding bonds as they become due and paying the interest on the same.

Section 2. The monthly rate for water shall be maintained as established by Ordinance No. 162 with the following exceptions that no rebate shall be allowed for payment on or before the 10th of the month and penalty of Twenty-Five Cents (.25) shall be added to the base rate for such monthly payment made after the 10th of the month when due. It is further ordained that water rentals outside the Town limits for residence purposes shall be Two and 15/100 Dollars (\$2.15) if paid on or before the 10th of the month when due with a Twenty-Five Cent (.25) penalty per month for each delinquency. All other rates to remain as at present without rebate for early payment.

Section 3. In order to establish and maintain an equitable charge so that water users will pay in accordance with service rendered and supply used it is further ordained that as soon as practicable a meter system shall be installed with rates as fixed by Ordinance No. 162.

Section 4. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith is hereby repealed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall become effective on and after August 1, 1944.
