

ORDINANCE NO. 177

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, PROVIDING A CHARGE FOR THE SAME AND CANCELLING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES PREVIOUSLY ENACTED RELATING THERETO.

BE IT ENACTED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: That because of the increased cost of collecting garbage and expense connected with the maintenance of the garbage and expense connected with the maintenance of the garbage dump it has become necessary to increase the charges therefore in some instances.

Section 2: That commencing January 1, 1947, a charge of 25 cents monthly, payable in advance to the Town Treasurer at the time water rent is paid, shall be made against every householder or place of business requiring such service, provided that such collection shall not exceed in quantity such an amount as may be contained in two ordinary garbage cans in any one month and if such collection from any house or place of business exceeds such amount then an additional charge of 25 cents per can shall be made and provided further that if more than one collection is necessary in any one month that an additional charge of \$2.50 shall be made for each collection.

Section 3: That all garbage to be collected shall be only for dry material and no sloppy matter or dead animals shall be included in the garbage.

Section 4: That all garbage shall be placed in suitable containers for easy handling and left in a convenient place for collection and shall not be allowed to accumulate in any manner so as to become offensive or dangerous to health or disposed of in any other manner about the premises. That the date for collection shall be the last Saturday in each month.

Section 5: That this ordinance is necessary for the protection and health of the people and failure to comply with any part thereof shall be deemed a misdemeanor and upon conviction therefore shall be subject to a find of not less than \$5.00 or more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment in the town jail not exceeding 30 days or by both such find and imprisonment. This ordinance shall become effective upon passage, approval and publication.
