

ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATING OF ALL SLOT MACHINES, PIN BALL MACHINES, AND ALL MACHINES OF SKILL OR CHANCE WHICH USE A COIN OF 5 CENTS OR LARGER TO OPERATE SAID MACHINE OR DEVICE IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: Any person, firm or corporation who shall have in his or their possession, or shall place or permit to be placed or kept in any building or part thereof, owned, leased or occupied by him or them, any slot machine, pinball machine, or machines of skill or chance or other article, device or apparatus operated for the losing or winning of money, merchandise, or game of skill, such machines using a coin of 5 Cents or larger to operate, shall pay into the Town Treasury: Twelve dollars and fifty cents (\$12.50) per month for 1-ball play pinball machines; 5-ball no payout amusement device, two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per month for each machine; Twenty dollars (\$20.00) a month for 10c machines; Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) a month for 25c machines, and thirty-five Dollars (\$35.00) a month for 50c machines. All license fees payable quarterly in advance.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Failure on the part of any person, firm or corporation to make payment as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance on all such slot machines, or apparatus, in his or their possession, will be fined twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) a day for each day of operation thereof.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon due passage and publication.
