

ORDINANCE NO. 184

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LICENSING AND REGULATING OF ALL PUNCH BOARDS AND JUKE BOXES TO OPERATE IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: Any person, firm or corporation who shall have in his possession, or shall place or permit to be placed or kept in any building, or part thereof, owned, leased or occupied by him, any punch board or juke box, shall pay into the Town Treasury, two dollars (\$2.00 stamp) on each and every punch board; and two dollars and fifty cents (\$2.50) per month for each and every juke box. All license fees payable quarterly in advance.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: Failure on the part of any person, firm or corporation to make payment as provided in Section 1 of this ordinance on all such punch boards and juke boxes in his or their possession will be fined the sum of ten dollars (\$10.00) for each day of operation thereof.

Section 4: This ordinance will be in full force and effective upon due passage and publication.
