ORDINANCE NO. 189

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF A CAUCUS WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE PURPOSE OF NOMINATING COUNCILMEN AND OTHER ELECTED OFFICERS FOR SUCH TOWN TO BE ELECTED AT A GENERAL ELECTION HELD THEREIN ON THE SECOND TUESDAY IN MARCH.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That a caucus shall be held on the third Monday in February, at the city hall in Granite Falls, Washington for the purpose of nominating councilmen and other elected officials for said town, the hours of such caucus to be at 8 p.m. on said day.

Section 2: Any ordinance prior to and in conflict herewith, is hereby repealed.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its publication.
