

ORDINANCE NO. 201

PERTAINING TO THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS

WHEREAS, ON THIS 18th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1955, A PUBLIC HEARING WAS HELD BEFORE THE GRANITE FALLS TOWN COUNCIL PERTAINING TO THE PASSAGE OF AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS AS AUTHORIZED BY THE 1955 SESSION OF THE STATE LEGISLATURE.

NOW, THEREFORE, on motion duly made and unanimously passed, the following ordinance is hereby introduced.

Section 1: No person, firm or corporation shall hereafter erect, construct, enlarge, shore, underpin, repair, improve, convert or otherwise alter any building or structure in the Town of Granite Falls for which the value of the materials exceed \$500 without first obtaining a separate building permit for each such buildings or structure from the town council of Granite Falls,

Section 2: To obtain a permit the applicant shall fill out a blank permit form to be supplied by the Town of Granite Falls. The applicant shall include thereon:

- A. The permittee's name and address.
- B. A legal description of the property on which the building or structure is located or will be located.
- C. A general description of the nature of the proposed work.
- D. The estimated value of the materials to be used in the proposed work.

The permit form may be signed by the permittee or his authorized agent who may be required to submit evidence to indicate such an authority.

Section 3: Upon payment of a fee of \$5.00, the Town Clerk shall sign the permit and shall issue the original thereof to the applicant and immediately transmit a copy to the county assessor.

All such fees collected hereunder shall be deposited with the Town Treasurer and credited to the current expense fund.

Section 4: Any person violating a portion of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor. Each such violation shall constitute a separate offense and shall be punishable as such.

Section 5: If any section or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such section or portion shall be deemed a separate provision of this ordinance and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 6: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent or in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.

Section 7: This ordinance shall take effect October 1, 1955.
