## ORDINANCE NO. 202

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE BE ADOPTED:

Section 1: Any person being found guilty in the police court or Granite Falls and a fine imposed for the violation of any of the ordinances of said town, shall in lieu of cash be required to work out any and all such fines by labor on the public works.

Section 2: The street and water superintendent of public works of the town shall have charge of and supervise the work.

Section 3: Any person or persons working out such fines by labor on public works, shall be allowed the sum of \$3.00 per day until the amount of such fine is paid, as ordered by the Town of Granite Falls, Police Court.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect as soon as passed and published as prescribed by law.
