

ORDINANCE NO. 205

AN ORDINANCE SUBMITTING TO THE QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS A PROPOSITION AUTHORIZING A SPECIAL LEVY UPON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS IN THE YEAR 1958 PAYABLE IN THE YEAR 1959 OF APPROXIMATELY FOUR (4) MILLS, WHICH SHALL BE IN ADDITION TO THE FIFTEEN MILLS AND OTHER LEVIES AUTHORIZED BY ARTICLE VII, SECTION 2, AS ENACTED BY AMENDMENT 17 OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON, FOR THE PURPOSE OF RAISING \$900.00 FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATION OF A PUBLIC LIBRARY IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE COUNTY LIBRARY; CREATING A SPECIAL FUND TO BE KNOWN AS "LIBRARY FUND, SPECIAL LEVY"; PROVIDING FOR THE FORM OF BALLOT TO BE USED AT SAID ELECTION; DECLARING AN EMERGENCY TO EXIST; AND DIRECTING THE COUNTY AUDITOR TO HOLD A SPECIAL ELECTION ON THE 9th DAY OF SEPTEMBER, 1958.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town of Granite Falls, does ordain:

Section 1: That it is found and declared that an emergency does hereby exist requiring the submission of the proposition herein set forth, and the County Auditor of Snohomish County is hereby directed to hold a special election on September 9, 1958, in the Town of Granite Falls in conjunction with the state primary election for the submission of the proposition herein set forth. The Town Clerk is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this ordinance to the County Auditor.

Section 2: That there shall be submitted to the qualified electors of the Town of Granite Falls at a special election to be held September 9, 1958, a proposition authorizing the said town to levy a tax upon real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls in the year 1958 payable in the year 1959 of approximately four (4) mills, which shall be in addition to the fifteen mills and other levies authorized by Article VII, Section 2, as enacted by Amendment 17 of the Constitution of the State of Washington, for the purpose of raising \$900.00 for maintenance and operation of a public library in conjunction with the County Library.

Section 3: That the form of ballot to be used at said election shall be as follows:

Special Levy, Library Fund;

Shall the Town of Granite Falls be authorized to levy in the year 1958 a tax of approximately 4 mills, which shall be in addition to the 15 mills and other

levies authorized by Amendment 17 of the Constitution of the State of Washington, for the purpose of raising \$900.00 for maintenance and operation of a public library in conjunction with the County Library.

Section 4: That there is hereby created a special fund to be known as "Library Fund, Special Levy" and there shall be paid into said fund \$900.00 to be raised by a levy of approximately 4 mills and any other proceeds that may be derived from said levy.
