## ORDINANCE NO. 211

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1960, INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE POLICE JUDGE, AND APPROPRIATING ANY MONIES IN THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND TO PROVIDE THE SUM OF NINE HUNDRED DOLLARS FOR THE BALANCE OF THE YEAR 1960, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the town council of Granite Falls, Wash:

Section 1: A public emergency is declared to exist, necessitating the increasing of the salary of the Police Judge, and which could not have been foreseen at the time of making the budget, and which is necessary for the protection of the public safety.

Section 2: The salary of the Police Judge is hereby set at One Hundred Forty-six Dollars and Sixty-seven cents per month for the balance of the year 1969, and the money shall be paid out of the Current Expense Fund.

Section 3: The budget for 1960 is hereby amended.
