

ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE APPOINTMENT AND CONFIRMATION OF A POLICE COURT CLERK, FILLING VACANCIES IN SAID OFFICE, PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF SAID POLICE COURT CLERK AND SETTING HIS COMPENSATION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: The mayor shall appoint, subject to the confirmation of the Town Council, a court clerk who shall hold office during the pleasure of the mayor, as provided by the laws of the State of Washington.

Section 2: The court clerk shall keep all books, records and proceedings of the court.

Section 3: The court clerk shall receive a monthly salary of twenty dollars (\$20.00) for his services rendered.

Section 4: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
