

ORDINANCE NO. 215

AN ORDINANCE CREATING A FUND TO BE KNOWN AS THE ARTERIAL STREET FUND; SPECIFYING THE MONEYS TO BE PLACED THEREIN; DESIGNATING THE USE THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR THE EXPENDITURE THEREOF; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls do ordain as follows:

1. That there is hereby created a fund to be known as the Arterial Street Fund, pursuant to Chapter 7, Laws of the 1961 Extraordinary Session of the State of Washington.
2. That said arterial street fund shall be credited with all applicable state gas tax allocated to the Town of Granite Falls, funds contributed by the Town of Granite Falls and any other funds that may from time to time be authorized to be placed therein.
3. That said arterial street fund shall be used exclusively for the construction, improvement and repair of the arterial streets in the Town of Granite Falls, and all expenditures from said fund shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Washington.
4. An urgency and emergency for the passage of this ordinance is hereby declared to, and does exist, and the same shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage.
