

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND FIXING THE SALARY OF THE POLICE JUDGE FOR THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington:

Section 1: The salary of the police judge shall be and is hereby fixed at fifty dollars (\$50.00) per month.

Section 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication as required by law.
