

ORDINANCE NO. 22

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE BOUNDARIES OF VOTING PRECINCTS IN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS PROVIDING A PLACE WHERE ELECTIONS SHALL BE HELD FOR THE APPOINTING OF A BOARD OF ELECTION AND REGULATING THE CONDUCT OF ELECTIONS FOR TOWN OFFICERS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That there shall be but one voting precinct in the town of Granite Falls comprising all of the territory included in the corporate limits of the Town of Granite Falls.

Section 2: That the regular voting place for all town elections shall be at some building to be designated by the council within the limits of the town of Granite Falls.

Section 3: That whenever an election is to be held the Town Council shall appoint a board of election to supervise said election consisting of one Inspector, two Judges and two clerks of Election whose compensation shall be three (\$3.00) per day each.

Section 4: At least ten days before the holding of any town election for the election of town officers or other municipal purposes, it shall be the duty of the Town clerk to cause to be published in a newspaper printed and published in the Town of Granite Falls if there be such a paper, a notice of such election which shall state the purpose of said election, the date thereof and the names of officers if any to be filled at said election.

Section 5: The Town Clerk shall also post three printed or written notices containing the same information provided for in Section 4 hereof and if there be no newspaper of general circulation printed and published in the Town of Granite Falls, then the posed notices herein provided for shall be sufficient notice of the holding of any election of town officers or for other municipal purposes.

Section 6: All elections of town officers or other municipal purposes within the town of Granite Falls, shall be conducted under the provisions of the general election law of the State of Washington.

~~Section 7: The registration books of voters shall be closed by the Town Clerk twenty days before the holding of any municipal election and kept closed until the said election has been fully completed.~~

Section 8: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
