

ORDINANCE NO. 220

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING CERTAIN REAL PROPERTY TO THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, AS PROVIDED BY CHAPTER 35.13 OF THE REVISED CODE OF WASHINGTON.

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That on the 9th day of June, 1965, there was received by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls and filed with the said Clerk of the Town, a petition praying that the boundary of the said Town be altered by including therein certain real property lying contiguous to the Town of Granite Falls, the legal description of which is set forth below, said petition having been signed by the owners of property of not less than 75 Percent of the assessed valuation of all of the real property within the following described area.

Section 2: That the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls entertained said petition and gave notice of hearing as required by law, by posting and publication, and that said hearing was held on the 30th day of June, 1965, at 8:00 p.m. in the Council chambers of the Town Hall of the Town of Granite Falls and that no person appeared to voice disapproval of the proposed annexation.

Section 3: That on the 30th day of June, 1965, a Review Board found that the proposed annexation is in the public interest and in the public welfare and is in the best interest of the Town of Granite Falls, the County of Snohomish, the Granite Falls School District No. 332 and the area to be annexed.

Section 4: That the territory proposed by said petition to be annexed to the Town of Granite Falls is situated in the County of Snohomish, State of Washington, and is contiguous, proximate and adjacent to the present corporate limits of said town and is particularly bounded and described as follows, to wit:

A portion of the Southwest quarter of Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 7 East, W.M., more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at the northwest corner of the southeast quarter of the southwest quarter of Section 18, township 30 North, Range 7 East, W.M., thence east 264 feet; thence north 165 feet; thence east 264 feet; thence north 165 feet; thence east to the west line of right-of-way of the Robe-Menzel Lumber Company railroad; thence southeasterly along said west line of Robe-Menzel Lumber Company railroad right-

of-way to the north boundary of Union Street extended which is also the southeast corner of Tract No. 11 of Martha E. Turner's Acre Tracts; thence west along north boundary of Union Street extended to east boundary of Alder Avenue; thence north along east boundary of Alder Avenue to the True Point of Beginning.

Section 5: That the above described real property be and the same is hereby annexed to and incorporated into the Town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and five days following its publication as required by law.
