

ORDINANCE NO. 225

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A BACK-HOE AND LOADER FOR USE BY THE WATER AND SEWER DEPARTMENTS.

Section 1: An emergency hereby exists because the ditch digger and the loader owned by the Town of Granite Falls is beyond reasonable repair.

Section 2: That approximately two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) is required to purchase a back-hoe for the water department and approximately two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) is required to purchase a loader for the sewer department.

Section 3: The operation of the water and sewer departments cannot be properly conducted to preserve the public health and welfare without the use of a back-hoe and loader.

Section 4: Therefore be it ordained by the Town Council of Granite Falls that a back-hoe and a loader be purchased for use by the water and sewer departments.

Section 5: That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
