

ORDINANCE NO. 23

AN ORDINANCE GRANTING TO CHAS. T. SMITH, HIS SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS THE RIGHT AND PRIVILEGE TO LAY, MAINTAIN AND OPERATE PIPES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION AND SALE OF ACETYLENE GAS WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 1: That for a period of twenty-five (25) years from the date of the passage of this ordinance Chas. T. Smith, his successors and assigns, be and he is hereby given and granted the right and privilege to construct, operate and maintain a system for the distribution and sale of acetylene gas, and for such purpose shall have the right to lay pipes underground along and across, the streets, alleys, avenues, and public places of the town of Granite Falls, Washington.

Section 2: That such system shall be constructed and in operation within ninety (90) days after the passage and publication of this ordinance.

Section 3: That the said grantee shall repair any and all public streets, alleys or avenues disturbed by it in constructing, repairing or operating said system, in as good state and condition as before, and upon failure so to do, the Town of Granite Falls shall have the right to repair the same and charge the expense thereof against said system and such charges and expense shall be a first and prior lien upon said system until paid.

Section 4: This ordinance shall have no force or effect unless the said grantee shall within 30 days file with the town clerk of said town his written acceptance of the same.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
