

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE DECLARING THAT AN EMERGENCY EXISTS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT BUDGET AND APPROPRIATING APPROXIMATELY \$2,750.00 FOR SALARIES AND EXPENSE FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FOR THE REMAINDER OF 1967.

Section 1: (a) WHEREAS, the cost of law enforcement has exceeded the amount budgeted for 1967, and

(b) WHEREAS, the cost of continued operation of the Police Department for 1967 will require approximately \$2,750.00, and

(c) WHEREAS, the continued operation of the Police Department is necessary to the Public welfare;

Section 2: THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, that \$2,750.00 be transferred from the Current Expense Fund to the Police Department to pay salaries and expense for the remainder of 1967.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
