

ORDINANCE NO. 248

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF HOMER AVENUE LYING BETWEEN GALENA STREET AND STANLEY STREET

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, do ordain:

Section 1. WHEREAS, a petition was filed with the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls by certain persons for the vacation of that portion of Homer Avenue lying northerly of the north right of way line of Galena Street and southerly of the south right of way line of Stanley Street, and it appearing that said persons own more than 2/3rds of all of the property abutting on that portion of the street to be vacated;

Section 2. WHEREAS, a hearing was had on the 14th day of April, 1971, at 9:00 o'clock, p.m. before the Town Council at the Council Chambers at the Town Hall upon said petition, pursuant to a resolution passed at a regular meeting of the Town Council on the 24th day of March, 1971, and, whereas a good and sufficient notice of hearing, pursuant to RCW 35.79.020, was posted in three of the most public places in the Town of Granite Falls and in conspicuous place on the portion of the street sought to be vacated, said posting having been done on the 30th day of March 1971.

Section 3. WHEREAS, no objections having been made to said petition and the said Council having found that the said street has not been opened and that it would be to the public interest and to the interest of the town, as an abutting property owner, that the petition be granted.

Section 4. The following described street in the Town of Granite Falls, Washington be and the same hereby is permanently vacated:

That portion of Homer Avenue lying Northerly of the north right of way line of Galena Street and Southerly of the South right of way line of Stanley Street in Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 7 East, W.M. (Martha E. Turner Acre Tracts), Granite Falls, Snohomish County, Washington.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be effective immediately upon its passage and posting.

PASSED at a regular meeting of the Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington held on the 14th day of April, 1971 and approved by the Mayor.
