

ORDINANCE NO. 249

AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AMOUNT OF LICENSE FEES FOR BUSINESS AND OCCUPATIONS AND AMENDING ORDINANCES 151 AND 153.

The Town Council of the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Effective for the license year commencing January 1, 1972, and all license years or portions thereof commencing thereafter, the annual license fee for all trades, occupations and lines of businesses for which a license is now required by ordinances of the Town of Granite Falls shall be \$20.00; provided however, that such license fee shall not apply to any business or occupation for which a license is required under the terms of Ordinance No. 246.

Section 2. Those sections of Ordinances Nos. 151 and 153, or portions thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same hereby are repealed.

Section 3. If any part or provision of this ordinance shall be adjudged illegal or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section 4. This ordinance shall become effective upon its passage in posting, except as otherwise provided in Section 1.
