

ORDINANCE NO. 252

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL TAX-
ABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE
YEAR 1972 IN THE TOTAL SUM OF \$15,431.08, REGULAR LEVY,
AND \$2,047.52, SPECIAL LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE
FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There is hereby levied upon the real and per-
sonal property within the Town of Granite Falls with respect
to the general levy for the year 1972 a tax of \$15,431.00
being 7.5 mills.

Section 2. There is hereby levied upon the real and per-
sonal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls,
Washington for the year 1972 pursuant to the special levy
adopted by the electors of the Town of Granite Falls at a
special election held on the 9th day of February, 1971,
the sum of \$2,047.52.

Section 3. The proceeds of the foregoing regular and
special levies are to be placed, \$12,344.86 in the Current
Expense Fund, \$3,086.22 in the Street Fund and \$2,047.52
in the Library Fund.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after
its passage, approval and posting; according to law.
