

ORDINANCE NO. 253

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL TAX-
ABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE
YEAR 1973 IN THE TOTAL SUM OF \$16,552.00, REGULAR LEVY,
AND \$2,207.00 SPECIAL LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE
FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied upon the real and
personal property within the Town of Granite Falls with
respect to the general levy for the year 1973 a tax of
\$16,552.00, being 7.5 mills.

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied upon the real and
personal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls
for the year 1973 pursuant to the special levy adopted by
the electors of the Town of Granite Falls at a special
election held on the 11th day of April 1972, the sum of
\$2,207.00.

SECTION 3. The proceeds of the foregoing regular and
special levies are to be placed, \$13,242.00 in the Current
Expense Fund, \$3,310.00 in the Street Fund and \$2,207.00
in the Library Fund.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from and
after its passage, approval and posting; according to law.
