

ORDINANCE NO. 257

AN ORDINANCE LEVYING A TAX ON THE REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY WITHIN THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS FOR THE YEAR 1974 IN THE TOTAL SUM OF \$21,580.00 REGULAR LEVY, AND \$2,300.00 SPECIAL LEVY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF GRANITE FALLS, WASHINGTON, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal property within the Town of Granite Falls with respect to the levy for the year, 1974 a tax of \$21,580.00, being 7.5 mills.

SECTION 2. There is hereby levied upon the real and personal taxable property within the Town of Granite Falls, Washington, for the year 1974 pursuant to the special levy adopted by the electors of the Town of Granite Falls at a special election held on the 18th day of September, 1973, the sum of \$2,300.00.

SECTION 3. The proceeds of the foregoing regular and special levies are to be placed; \$15,826.00 in the Current Expense Fund, \$5,754.00 in the Street Fund and \$2,300.00 in the Library Fund.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, approval and posting; according to law.
